MINUTES OF MEETING OF CANVASSING AUTHORITY
AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS SPECIAL MEETING

May 13, 2026

The Canvassing Authority (the "Canvassing Authority") of the Board of Directors (the "Board" or "Directors") of Brookshire Municipal Water District (the "District") met in special session on the 13th day of May, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., in the meeting room of the District, 4004 6th Street, Brookshire, Texas, pursuant to notice of said meeting posted in accordance with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

All members of the Canvassing Authority of the Board of the District were present, thus constituting a quorum. Also attending were Tonya Pierre ("General Manager"); and Elliot M. Barner, attorney, of Radcliffe Adams Barner PLLC ("Attorney" or "RAB") (via telephone).

WHEREUPON, the meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. by the Presiding Officer, and evidence was presented that public notice of the meeting had been given in compliance with the law. The posted notices of the meeting are available upon request.

Public Comments

The Presiding Officer first opened the meeting to public comment. There being no public comments, the Presiding Officer directed the Canvassing Authority of the Board to proceed with the agenda.

Election Report

Mr. Barner confirmed that there were at least two (2) Canvassing Authority Officers present, thus constituting a quorum, and reminded the Board that such meeting was for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the May 2, 2026 Road Facilities Bond Election (the "Bond Election") and declaring such returns to be official.

Presiding Officer Green then reviewed the Order Canvassing Returns and Declaring Results of the Bond Election with the Canvassing Authority.


Upon a **motion** by Officer Williams, seconded by Officer Jackson, after full discussion and questions being put to the Canvassing Authority, the Canvassing Authority voted unanimously to adopt the Order Canvassing Returns and Declaring Results of the Bond Election, a copy of which is available upon request, thereby declaring the Board of Directors of the District to issue bonds in the aggregate amount of the \$13,000,000 for the purpose of designing, purchasing, constructing, acquiring, owning, conveying, maintaining, operating, repairing, improving, extending, or paying for, inside and outside the boundaries of the Defined Area No. 1, roads and improvements, including storm drainage in aid of those facilities, necessary to serve the Defined Area No. 1 and to levy taxes adequate to provide for such bond within said Defined Area No. 1.

Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Board meeting was adjourned at 12:10 p.m.
